Continually monitor projects and work with clients to remedy or rectify any environmental damage together with a reduction in waste and conservation of resources.

Ensure all staff are working in a safe environment and are continually made aware of any potential deleterious impact of their work practises on the environment.

Ensure that each job has an individually tailored Risk Assessment and Method Statement (RAMS).This will be LLD's principle methodology by which the above policy objectives are achieved.

Ensure that local management and Directors implement and ensure compliance with this policy.
