Lone Worker Policy Statement

DEFINITION

A lone worker is anyone who works in isolation from their colleagues without close or direct supervision.

SCOPE

This policy applies to all employees whether permanent or temporary and includes any agency or professional working for and behalf of LLD. It also applies to Independent Contractors.

LEGAL REQUIREMENTS

Under the Health and Safety at Work Act 1974 places an obligation on employers to ensure Health, Safety and Welfare of its employees. The Management of Health and Safety at Work Regulations(MHSWR) 1999 places a duty on employers to identify significant risks with the working environment and implement suitable risk treatments, to reduce those risks so far as is reasonably practicable. This element is treated more extensively in the company's job specific risk assessment method statement (RAMS).

POLICY AIMS AND OBJECTIVES.

To ensure, that staff who work alone, so far as is reasonably practicable, are not exposed to risks to their health and safety and implement measures to reduce that risk. The aim is also designed to raise awareness on safety issues. The policy objective is to tailor precautionary measures to the particular characteristics of any project- for instance a traceable telephone log.

Whilst LLD have a policy statement on Lone Working, due to the nature of the business, there will be absolutely no "Lone Working".

Ensure that local management and Directors implement and ensure compliance with this policy.
